

A WINTER WALK IN MAIRANGI BAY

A walking route by Margaret Scrymgeour

The varied, and sometimes steep, walkways of Mairangi Bay are perfect for winter walking . This moderately strenuous walk gives a good workout but can easily be cut short if the weather deteriorates. Park anywhere in the Village – toilets near the Plunket Rooms .

Allow just under an hour/4.5Km/5000 steps approx.

From Montrose Tce:

Enter the wide walkway next to no 6 Montrose Tce. At the top veer slightly left, cross Brighton Tce and continue into Scarboro Tce. At Folkestone St turn left and at Beach Rd cross carefully then veer left into Hythe Tce. At the end enter the walkway between nos 40/41 and exit at 2/4 Marigold Pl.

Continue straight ahead up Honeysuckle Lane then turn sharp left into the **steep** walkway between nos 1/3 to exit at 10/12 Tudor Pl. Turn left into East Coast Rd then left down Hastings Rd. Cross Hastings Rd and just **opposite** Penzance Rd enter the steps down to Jeanette Pl (11/12).

From Jeanette Pl turn left into Amante Cres. At the bottom cross Maxwellton Dr and walk to the right before turning left into Mayfair Cres. At the end cross Maxwellton Dr once more and follow the track by the Volleyball courts round through the park, past the Arts Centre , out to Hastings Rd and back to the Village.
